

The importance of sleep

Over 100 years of designing excellent handcrafted mattresses has allowed us to create a sleep system that gives you the most peaceful night's sleep. The comfort and support of your Sleep to Live® sleep system will lull you to sleep and help you start each day at your best, revived and rejuvenated.

Nothing is more essential than starting each day at your best. Your decision to purchase a Sleep to Live® sleep system will help you finally get a good night's sleep. Your quality of life is determined by your quality of sleep.

Your new sleep system has been designed with your utmost comfort in mind. As a result, you will notice body conformity during normal use.

Body conformity is normal in quality mattresses. Your new system is designed to conform to the contours of your body allowing you a comfortable, healthy night's sleep. Body conformity will usually take place within the first nights, certainly within the first few weeks of use. Just like a new pair of shoes, a set of bedding conforms with the individual using it and becomes even more comfortable with use. If you notice some impressions, don't worry, this means that your mattress is conforming to your body.

Maintenance Suggestions

Take good care of your sleep system and it will take care of you.

No other piece of furniture will be used in our home more than your sleep system. Like a home appliance, your sleep system requires some minimum measures for your healthy sleep, night after night.

- A. Carry the mattress flat on its side. This way is easier and less likely to damage the mattress. If handles are provided, use for positioning on the box spring only. Be sure not to use the handles to move the mattress. They are not designed to do so.
- B. Keep your bedding clean. Use a mattress pad and wash it frequently with your bed linens. Vacuum the surface of the mattress to keep it free of skin debris that accumulates in normal use. If the mattress is soiled, the product warranty is void.
- C. Properly support your sleep system.

D. Use a proper frame and center support OR five rigid cross support slats OR a solid platform surface OR a surface that is deemed appropriate by Kingsdown, Inc. An improper support frame and lack of center support will void your product warranty.

Common Sense Safety Information

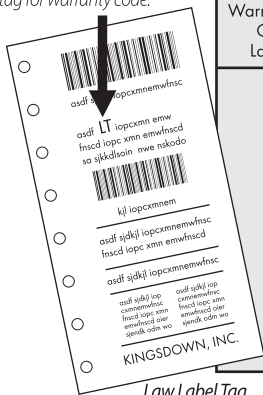
- A. Avoid placement of your sleep system near heaters or open flame. Don't smoke in bed. Your mattress is certified and made in accordance with the Federal Mattress Flammability Standard 16 CFR Part 1633.
- B. Use the sleep system for rest and relaxation, not a trampoline. Don't let anybody stand or jump on the sleep system. It is not designed for this kind of abusive weight concentration.
- C. Flex your muscles, not the mattress. Do not bend the mattress under any circumstances; this can damage the inner spring unit permanently. Use proper size/depth sheets to keep the corners of the mattress from bending.
- D. ***Leave the Law Label tag on your sleep set.***
Don't remove the Law Label at the end of the mattress and box spring. The tag serves as identification and enables you to exercise your warranty rights.

Warranty Coverage

Limited Warranty Coverage

We warrant to the original purchaser, subject to the terms provided in this warranty brochure, that the mattress and/or box spring manufactured by us which you have purchased ("Sleep to Live product") will be free from defects in material and workmanship. This limited warranty begins the day you purchase your set of bedding and will remain in effect until the Sleep to Live product is no longer owned by the original purchaser, or the limited warranty period (as shown to the right in the illustration) expires, whichever first occurs. If your set of bedding is replaced, this limited warranty will not be renewed or extended.

Bedding Set Only: When a Sleep to Live® mattress and matching box spring are purchased together as a set.

Mattress Only: When a Sleep to Live® mattress is purchased without matching box spring.

This warranty applies to:

Mattress *(both as a set or mattress only)*

- Coils or wires that are loose or broken.
- Coils or wires that protrude or rip through any fabric
- Sagging, but only when a mattress has been continuously supported by a matching box spring with an appropriate frame and center support OR five rigid cross support slats OR a solid platform surface. Sagging is defined as a 1 1/2" or greater indentation or severe compression of the inner-spring unit. The proper center support is required for all sleep systems regardless of the type and size of bed furniture used.

Box spring

- Splitting of the wood frames.
- Squeaks, rattles or noises.
- Compression of coils or modules.
- Sagging, but only when continuously used with an appropriate frame and center support of five rigid cross support slats. Sagging is defined as severe compression of the innerspring, coils or modules. The proper center support is required for all sleep systems regardless of the type and size of bed furniture used.

Only the defective piece or part will be replaced, not the entire set of bedding, unless the entire set is determined to be defective. Replacement of one piece will not automatically result in the replacement of the other piece.

In the event of replacement, Kingsdown, Inc. reserves the right to use the closest comparable materials or models and does not guarantee that the replacement will match the existing piece.

This warranty does not apply to:

- Covers (including stains, soiling, burns, etc.).
- Handles (which should be used only to position the mattress and may pull out if used to support the full weight of the mattress).
- Border wires, which run along the perimeter of the mattress and box spring, bent due to moving or bending the set of bedding.
- Structural damage due to using improper bed frame or support system.
- Comfort preference.
- Body impressions. Kingsdown, Inc. will not consider normal body impressions to constitute a defect in material or workmanship for purposes of this limited warranty.
- Mattress damage due to an inappropriate foundation or support system.
- Mattress or box spring from which the law tag has been removed.
- Mattress or box spring for which proof of date and place of purchase is not provided.
- Mattress or box spring which has been purchased as an item subject to sales terms "as is" or similar terms.
- Mattress or box spring sold by anyone other than Kingsdown, Inc. or an authorized Sleep to Live® retailer of which is owned by anyone other than the original consumer purchaser.
- Mattress or box spring if found to be in an unsanitary condition, or altered, abused or damaged through accident, neglect or improper usage, including stains of any type or origin.

Any and all implied warranties on your Sleep to Live® product, including any implied warranty of merchantability of fitness for a particular purpose, shall not exceed in duration the term during which this limited warranty is in effect.

The Sleep to Live retailer through whom you have purchased the product has no authority to extend or modify the terms of the limited warranty and no extension or modification of this limited warranty shall be authorized by or binding upon Kingsdown, Inc. If any defect covered by this limited warranty appears in the Sleep to Live product under normal use and service, while the limited warranty is in effect, we will replace at our option, the Sleep to Live product at no charge upon examination and verification by an authorized Sleep to Live representative.

Your sole remedy for any defect or deficiencies in the Sleep to Live® product you have purchased or for a breach of the limited warranty shall be to have Kingsdown, Inc. replace the Sleep to Live product in accordance with the terms and conditions of this limited warranty, and Kingsdown, Inc. shall not be liable to pay any consequential or incidental damages, or damages or expenses of any other nature whatsoever; arising from use or ownership of the Sleep to Live® product, or from breach of the limited warranty stated herein.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights that vary from state to state. Notification of claims under this limited warranty or other inquiries shall be directed to the Sleep to Live retailer from whom the Sleep to Live product was originally purchased, or if the retailer cannot be contacted, to Kingsdown, Inc. P.O. Box 388, Mebane, North Carolina 27302. After providing notification of your claim, you should then promptly follow the instructions provided by the retailer or by Kingsdown, Inc. **You must keep your sales receipt or other proof of purchase, and provide copies of these documents at the time you submit a claim under this limited warranty.** If it is necessary for Kingsdown, Inc. to handle the claim directly, then the original purchaser will pay the full cost of handling and transportation to and from the nearest Kingsdown, Inc. facility.
